MANTUA'S ODYSSEY OF THE MIND TEAM WINS THIRD PLACE IN THE VIRGINA STATE FINAL COMPETITION

Congratulations to our Mantua team of 4th, 5th and 6th graders who won 3rd Place in the Virginia State Finals of Odyssey of the Mind! The team members included: Josh Brandman, Eric Kirkland, Hannah Patton, Betsy Ryan, Josh Schiffres, Ryan Travis, and Brian Yudkin. They won for their solution to the problem, "Stunt Mobiles" in Division I and their performance in a Spontaneous Problem.

The head judge stated that this year's "Stunt Mobile" problem was the hardest vehicle problem they had seen. The team designed and built two "stunt" vehicles without outside help. The vehicles had to have different power sources (but not be human-powered) and be able to complete five obstacle courses without any remote guidance or other assistance once they crossed the start line. Together, the two vehicles had to fit in 7x11x15-inch box. After crossing the finish lines, the vehicles had to hit targets and then break balloons.

The running of the stunt mobiles was incorporated within a team-created performance. The team's performance, "X-treme Cows," really "mooved" the judges.

The second part of the competition included a "Spontaneous" problem in which the team worked together to creatively respond to a "Hands On" structure problem, in a seven minute time period. The team did not know the problem ahead of time. The team was scored on their problem solving abilities, creativity and how well they work together as a team.

Teams from across the state competed Saturday, April 16 at James Madison High School in Vienna. Our Assistant Principal, Cheryl Thompson, came to cheer our team on!
