Youth Art Month Tips: Discussing Art

With Children The art department wishes to inform everyone that *March is Youth Art Month (YAM)*. You can celebrate your child's art by hanging it in a special place in your home. Mat and frame their art work for a spectacular effect.

When discussing art work with your children it's better to let them talk. If you aren't sure what something is you can ask: "Tell me about this area. . ." It's also a good idea to refrain from using phrases like: "I like it!" Instead comment on their perseverance, dedication and exceptional ability to make choices. Sometimes artists have great success and sometimes great failure. The key is to encourage them to try!
