Join Girls on the Run

Girls on the Run is a 10-12 week before and after school program that uses the power of running to help pre grades 3 through 8 for a lifetime of self-respect and healthy living.

Each session of the twice-a-week program is led by trained female coaches who guide and mentor girls using running, playing games, and discussing topics such as dealing with body image and the media, resisting peer p healthy decisions, and contributing to the community. Along the way, the girls train together to walk or run mile) running event and celebration.

The goal of the program is to empower the girls with greater self-awareness, a sense of achievement, and a team building to help them become strong, contented, and self-confident young women.

How Much Does It Cost?

- *The Girls on the Run program fee includes:
- · Lessons conducted by certified GOTR® coaches
- · Participation in the 5K running event and celebration
- \cdot Healthy snacks at the end of each program session
- · Official GOTR t-shirt
- · Official GOTR 5K race t-shirt
- · Water bottle
- · Comprehensive insurance

The fees for the Spring 2010 Girls on the Run program are:

- · Standard fee: \$165
- · Fee for Coaches Daughters: \$85
- · Families that Qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program: \$70 (with the Free and Reduced Lunch Program)
- \cdot Free and Reduced Lunch Program families with income below \$30,000: \$17 (with the Free and Reduced Lur form)

Additional accommodations can be reached with the Girls on the Run of NOVA Executive Director as needed ever turned away due to financial need.

*The fee structure has been revised to align financial aid specifically with the needs of the families we serv assistance is now determined by individual Free and Reduced Lunch Program forms rather than by the Free Lunch Program percentage of the school.

How Do I Register?
