Helping Children Cope With Natural Disasters

Perhaps most important to keep in mind, are these tips for helping children in terms of crisis and stress:

- Try and keep routines as normal as possible. Kids gain security from the predictability of routine, including attending school.
- Limit exposure to television and the news.
- Be honest with kids and share with them as much information as they are

developmentally able to handle.

- Listen to kids' fears and concerns.
- Reassure kids that the world is a good place to be, but sometimes bad things happen.
- Parents and adults need to first deal with and assess their own responses to crisis and stress.
- Rebuild and reaffirm attachments and relationships.

A Message from FCPS: Rescheduled Date for Listening Tour on Fairfax

High-Lanier Middle Scope of Boundary Study

Fairfax County Public Schools has rescheduled one of the dates for a listening tour for parents and citizens to help determine which schools are included in the scope of study of the upcoming Fairfax High-Lanier Middle School boundary study. The meetings scheduled for October 29th at Fairfax High School and October 30th at Frost Middle School were cancelled due to inclement weather. The meeting at Fairfax High School has been rescheduled for Monday, November 26th, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. Citizens who registered for the meeting at Frost Middle School are welcome to sign up for the November 5th meeting at Robinson Secondary School, the November 12th meeting at Woodson High School, or the November 26th meeting at Fairfax High School.

The boundary study, which will begin in early 2013, will address current and projected overcrowding in Fairfax High and Lanier Middle Schools.
