- Family 2: Breakfast Foods (cereal, granola bars, oatmeal)
- Family 3: Snacks (fruit snacks, individual bags of goldfish, cookies, crackers, juice boxes)
- 3rd Grade: Peanut butter, sunflower butter, almond butter, jelly
- 4th Grade: Canned Goods (tuna, chicken, canned meats)
- 5th Grade: Canned Goods (vegetables, fruits, tomatoes and sauce)
- 6th Grade: Canned Goods (soup, ravioli, spaghetti-  
os, broth)
