Impact Aid Student-Parent Survey Going Out

10/31/17

Impact Aid programs and grants are designed to assist local school districts that enroll federally connected students. The increasing federal presence in our area and the significant tax exemptions available to federally connected personnel, businesses, and agencies, has permitted Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) to be eligible for federal Impact Aid grants.

The grants from these programs will become a part of FCPS general operating budget and are critical to ensuring that all children in FCPS receive an excellent education. FCPS anticipates receiving about \$3,000,000 annually in Impact Aid funds.

FCPS uses the Student-Parent Survey to identify federally connected students and to support our request for Impact Aid resources. Beginning October 31, the survey will be distributed to all FCPS families.

For each school-aged child in your household, please complete, sign, date, and return the survey to your child's

school by **November 8**. If sections 2 through 4 of the survey do not apply to you, just sign, date, and return the form by the due date. FCPS staff will process the information with the utmost confidentiality. To ensure complete accuracy, please use the pre-filled survey that will be sent home with your child on 10/31/17.

FLE Instructional Program Information

Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) provides a comprehensive, sequential Family Life Education (FLE) program for students in grades kindergarten through grade twelve. Instruction is seen as a partnership among parents and guardians, the school, and the community in supporting the learning essential to the development of strong families, positive relationships, and a healthy community.

Parents/guardians may choose to opt their child out of all or part of the Family Life Education program. Students who are opted out are provided with age-appropriate, non-punitive alternative health instruction, and every effort is made to foster respect for family choices. If you wish to opt your child out of all or part of FLE for this school year, opt out forms were included in your child's 1st day folders and are available online for Elementary (K-6) <u>https://tinvurl.com/yak8sz5m</u>. Please fill in the opt-out form and return it to your child's school prior to Family Life Education instruction.

FLE grade level-specific lessons and media that FCPS has streaming rights for are available for parents online in FCPS 24-7 (Blackboard) Parent View https://fcps.blackboard.com/. Grade level-specific lessons are also available at the Fairfax County Regional Library in the City of Fairfax (this location does not have media).
