Mantua first grader Cameron McClain was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL), Philadelphia Chromosome positive (PH+), late last year. He is currently undergoing chemotherapy in preparation for a bone marrow transplant in February. As part of his treatment, Cameron requires frequent blood transfusions.

To show our support to Cameron and his family, Mantua Elementary and Annandale Preschool are co-sponsoring a blood drive on Thursday, January 22, from 11:00 - 5:00 in the social hall of the Little River United Church of Christ, at 8410 Little River Turnpike (across from NOVA). # Regarding Web Page Error Messages

A few people have commented that error messages appear when they go to the PTA web site. If you are using Internet Explorer, it may be possible to turn off the messages:

- Click the Tools menu, and select Internet Options.
- Click the Advanced tab.
- Find the line item "Disable script debugging," and ensure it is checked.
- Find the line item "Display a notification about every script error," and ensure it is NOT checked.
- Click OK

Error messages are a great help to web developers, but no use at all to other users. Feel free to turn them off!
