5. Immunizations required for Rising 6th Graders

For students entering 6th grade in the school year 2009-10, a booster dose of Tdap will be required.

Female students entering 6th grade next year (2009-10) will also be required to have the HPV (human papillomavirus) immunization.

Please make arrangements to bring your child up-to-date on these required immunizations, or if you already have, please provide the Clinic with documentation of the immunizations.
