School Board Accepting Applications for Facilities Planning Advisory Council

The Fairfax County School Board will be accepting applications from citizens interested serving on the newly created Facilities Planning Advisory Council (FPAC) through Wednesday, July 14. The School Board established FPAC at its May 20, meeting to advite Board in developing comprehensive, long-term plans for FCPS facility needs.

Among the issues council members will be considering are school program capacity,

transportation and operating efficiencies, financing and construction strategies, school renovations and closures, and planning for new buildings and boundaries. The School Board will appoint 13 members to the council: one from each Fairfax County magisteri district, three at-large representatives, and one representative from the City of Fairfax.
