# Mantua Students Win FIRST Lego League Award

A FIRST Lego League (FLL) team of five students (four from Mantua and one from Louise Archer Elementary School in Vienna) won a 2nd Place Champions Award for Division 1 in a VA/DC regional competition. FLL is an organization formed to inspire young people to be science and technology leaders, by designing and programming Lego Mindstorms NXT robots to complete tasks. The students work out solutions to the various problems they are given and then meet for regional tournaments to share their knowledge, compare ideas, and display their robots. The 2009 Virginian/DC FLL Regional Tournament was held at the Smithsonian Museum in Washington, DC on Saturday, November 14. The team of 5th and 6th graders won the award in their first competition, and has been selected to go to the state competition.
