Annandale Boundary Update

The four options developed by staff for consideration as ways to deal with the overcrowding at Annandale High School and to create boundaries at the new elementary school at the Lacey Center site have been posted. Option 1 proposes minimal changes, Option 2 reduces split feeders and attendance islands, Option 3 moves toward more K-6 schools, and Option 4 proposes nonboundary solutions. Here is the link:
