Woodson Bus Depot Information Meeting Scheduled

Supervisor John Cook invites you to learn more about an application submitted by Fairfax County Public Schools to create a new parking area (NPA) for 51 school busses serving area schools and their drivers. An information meeting will be held Thursday, Oct. 14, at 7:30 p.m. in the Woodson cafeteria.

The proposed bus lot would sit on approximately 2.4 acres of land in the northeast corner of Woodson High School grounds near the intersection of Pickett Road and Rt. 236.

FCPS staff will present the most recent layout for its proposal. Planning Commissioner Suzanne Harsel and Supervisor Cook will be present to hear your comments, concerns and recommendations. County planning staff also will be present to discuss the application, known as 2232-B-10-16, process, and what criteria it considers in making its recommendations.

This application currently is under review by the Fairfax County Department of Planning and

Zoning. A public hearing before the Fairfax County Planning Commission is scheduled for Dec. 2. To speak before the Planning Commission on this issue, call 703-324-2865 before to 3 p.m. on the day of the hearing, or sign up online at <u>http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/planning/speaker.htm</u>.
