Fairfax County Public Schools has long supported peer mediation as a means of resolving conflicts in schools. Mantua currently has nine sixth graders trained as Peer Mediators available to help students resolve conflicts. Peer mediators are trained to listen to both sides of the story, help students brainstorm possible solutions, and assist students in coming up with an agreement that works for both students. The school counselors supervise mediations, and students agree to keep information confidential. Students may 'self-refer' for peer mediation, or can be referred by their teachers. What About that Lottery Money?

The public perception is that education should be in no trouble because we are showered with lottery funds. To put the lottery proceeds for education in perspective, State General Fund Aid to Education in FY 2012 will be \$4.9 billion. The lottery proceeds for education in that year will be \$435.2 million.

This money is not "bonus money" for our schools. It is used to fund ongoing programs, so the lottery is, in effect, just another tax to fund essential programs. If we did not have a lottery, these programs would need to be funded from the General Fund and a new revenue source would be needed.
