Mantua's Odyssey of the Mind Team Wins Local Competition

On March 31, Mantua's Odyssey of the Mind team competed at the Northern Virginia Odyssey of the Mind Competition and won 1st place! The team, which includes 6th graders SeoJin Ahn, James Livingston, Justin Kane, and Jayson Mangis, as well as 4th grader Jenna Mangis and 2 grader Justin Mangis, worked hard to address the "To Be or Not To Be" problem. In this classics problem, the team put a humorous, musical theatre spin on one of William Shakespeare's most famous lines: "To Be Or Not To Be." They created a character who pondered a similar question, in a team-created dilemma. They also incorporated a character that portrayed Hamlet's conscience, a creative scene change, a creative costume change, and the use of a "trap door." The team spent 6 months creating a skit, building props, making their costumes, composing music, song and dance, and presenting their solution, which needed to be less than 8 minutes in length. They competed this past weekend in the Virginia State Championship in Newport News, VA.
