Reminder: No Bus Passes Will be Allowed Through September

No student will be allowed to ride home on a bus other than his or her own through

Starting in October, if your child is going home with a friend both parents must notify the office. If permission is not received by both parents then each child is to go to his/her normal destinations after school. Only under extreme circumstances will the office call for permission.

Parking in Horner Court Cul-de-sac

Be careful when parking at the school. Cars will be ticketed for parking in the fire lane (yellow curb area from the fire hydrant to corner) on the Horner Court culde-sac facing the school. Please do not park in this area. Some cars may park parallel past the yellow curb towards the first house. However, you must keep a good distance from the mailbox and driveway.

Shared Snacks/Party Treats Must be Nut-Free

Please bring nut-free snacks only in those cases where snacks are being shared with all classmates. If your child finds nut snacks to be the food of choice, they can bring it, but please have your child understand that is his or her snack only and cannot to be shared. At lunch there is a nut-free table system in place. In the classroom, it can be a bit more difficult to monitor. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.

Creating/Accessing FCPS Blackboard Accounts

If you are not familiar with Blackboard, it's a great way learn more about your children's classes, assignments, information and announcements. In order to see your children's Blackboard information you must first set up an account through Parent View. Once you receive confirmation of the account you need to bring that information along with a photo ID to the front office of your child's school to receive access.

You must use the same address and phone number that your child's school has on file in order to get a confirmation number. This account will give you viewing access to ALL of your childrens' Blackboard accounts as long as you enter them during the initial registration. Parents should use their parent accounts, not their children's to view class information.
