Mantua Division B Science Olympiad

Manuta's Division B Science Olympiad team recently competed in two area tournaments. Team members Amartya Banerjee, Rohan Selvan, Catherine Tadlock, Sarah Tadlock, Todd Tran, and Sanjay Venkatesan have been meeting and practicing since early January, and were one of the smallest teams and youngest teams in the entire competition. They competed mostly against 7th and 8th grade participants.

In late January, the students participated in the Fairfax Invitational competition against 34 other middle school teams. Catherine Tadlock and Sarah Tadlock earned fifth place medals for Metric Mastery, an event where they had to use mathematics and estimation skills to determine measurements of various items. In early March, the team attended a regional event with 20 other teams, where Todd Tran and Sanjay Venkatesan won third place in Rotor Egg Drop, an engineering event where they designed an invention to slow the descent of a raw egg dropped from a height and to protect the egg from cracking.
