Woodson High School Presents The Hobbit

Woodson High School Drama Club presents *The Hobbit*. It's the last thing that any sensitive Hobbit would want to do, but great benefit could eventually result-not only for Bilbo but for all of the Hobbits who inhabit Middle Earth-and will capture the hearts of those children and adults who continue to enjoy this kind of magic.

Help Fully Restore Fairfax County's Colvin Mill

Mantua 3rd graders recently visited Colvin Mill on a field trip. For the past four decades, only the basement and first floor of the Fairfax County mill have been open to the public. The Park Authority site is a finalist in a web-based contest sponsored by the National Trust for Historic Preservation and American Express.

Go to www.PartnersinPreservation.com to vote daily. The site with the greatest number of votes will receive \$100,000 in preservation prize money. Polls are open through May 10th. Colvin Run Mill would use the prize money to fully restore the second and third levels, complete with functioning equipment to dry and sift flour and meal the old-fashioned way. Then, visitors can see how the mill works from top to bottom!
