If you are the parent of a deaf child, a teacher, a babysitter, a relative, or are interested in working with deaf students in Fairfax County Schools, you are welcome to attend free classes to learn Cued American English. Introduction and First Class on Tuesday, September 18th, 2012, 6:30–8:00 p.m. Classes 1 ½ hours each and are held on consecutive Tuesdays for 8 weeks. These FREE classes are held at Canterbury Woods Elementary School, 4910 Willet Drive in Annandale.

Cued Speech is a visual system of communication which allows a deaf person access to the phonemes of a language. In Cued American English, the 40 phonemes (sounds) that combine to form all of the words in spoken English are represented with 8 hand shapes and 4 placements around the face.
