Back to School Night: 4th-6th Grades

Keep in Touch Account for Parents

After registering for parent view and having their account validated at one of their children's schools, parents will have their own username and password to access all of their children's available classes. They will be able to update their children's emergency information through wecare@school. Updating wecare@school with the correct email address will ensure better communication via Keep in Touch. On Back to School night from 6:00-7:00 p.m. and again from 7:30-8:30 p.m. you can get assistance signing up in the upstairs computer lab, room 50. Staff members will be there to assist you. Before creating a parent account, please be sure to have the student ID numbers for your children available. You can find the FCPS student ID

number on report cards.

Registration is Now Open for Foreign Languages

The Mantua PTA in conjunction with FCPS is pleased to offer a foreign language program before and after school.
