Bus Passes and Kiss & Ride Passes

At Mantua we have a pass system established for days when students are not going home from school by the usual method. This system has been set up to safeguard your children. Please send an email no later than 12:00 p.m. of the day of the change to Barbara. Hinton@fcps.edu so that she can prepare the appropriate pass. If your student is going home with a friend, both families will need to contact Mrs. Hinton. FCPS transportation will allow bus passes for students to go home with a friend beginning October 1st. Again, both families will need to contact Mrs. Hinton in this situation.

In addition, if your student is being picked up early during the school day, please notify the office as early as possible in the day. Many students have varied schedules,

and it can be time-consuming to track them down when you arrive. Please feel free to copy your child's homeroom teacher on any emails you send. Contact Barbara Hinton with any questions.

Student's Rights and Responsibilities Forms

All Mantua students received a copy of the Student's Rights and Responsibilities, which contains the School Boards Standards of Student Conduct. This included a form that students and parents must sign. If your child has not yet returned a signed copy of the Student's Rights and Responsibilities, we ask that they do this as soon as possible. Without this form, students will not have access to the school's computers nor will they be allowed to go on any scheduled field trips. Forms should be returned to student's homeroom teachers.

- •If your child has food allergies, our after school programs will not necessarily have someone on hand that is trained in the administering of EpiPens. We will be asking all families to send in peanut- and tree nut-free snacks with their child, and children will not be allowed to share snacks. However, if you are still concerned, please plan to attend the class with your child.
- •Children that are normally a part of the SACC after school program that participate in Robotics (or any other after school PTA program) will be walked to the SACC room at the end of the class, unless picked up by a parent. If your child does not usually participate in the SACC program, you (or a designee listed on your registration) must pick your child up at the end

of the class.
