Important Parking Information from the Police Department!

Families in our immediate Mantua Elementary neighborhood have expressed concerns to the Fairfax County Police Department regarding the following: illegally parked cars near the school which prohibit residents from accessing their driveway, parked cars blocking the flow of traffic, and adults and children not making use of the crosswalks.

As a result of these concerns, you may have recently seen a digital sign posted by the Police Department to remind drivers to adhere to parking regulations and proper use of crosswalks. In an effort to educate and enforce traffic laws, police officers may be stationed at the corner of Southwick and Kirkwood as well as near our Kiss & Ride to monitor the flow of traffic. At some point, officers will move into enforcing parking and crosswalk laws by issuing tickets to violators.

As a reminder, those of you who park in front of the school on the other side of the

grassy island need to park facing Kirkwood and not the cul-de-sac. Cars parked in the wrong direction will be ticketed. If you need to park your car on Kirkwood, be sure that your car is at least 10 feet away from a driveway. Also, please make sure you leave enough room for buses and cars to pass. If your parked car does not allow for the flow of traffic, tickets may be issued.

On a side note, during the week of October 22nd, police officers will be passing out literature regarding car seat regulations. They will also be available to help make sure car seats are installed properly for any interested parties.

Bus Passes and Kiss & Ride Passes

At Mantua we have a pass system established for days when students are not going home from school by the usual method. This system has been set up to safeguard your children. Please send an email <u>no later than 12:00 p.m.</u> of the day of the change to <u>Barbara.Hinton@fcps.edu</u> so that she can prepare the appropriate pass. If your student is going home with a friend, both families will need to contact Mrs. Hinton. Bus passes will be issued if the students plan to ride the bus.

In addition, if your student is being picked up early during the school day, please notify the office as early as possible in the day. Many students have varied schedules, and it can be time-consuming to track them down when you arrive. Please feel free to copy your child's homeroom teacher on any emails you send.
