Student Directory: IMPORTANT UPDATE

The PTA is in the process of creating this year's student and family Directory. The front office's new system has created some challenges for the process, and the Directory will be released later than usual, but HERE'S HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- Each family will be receiving a system-generated email soon, containing your family's current information.
- Please monitor all parent email in-boxes for the message, and follow the directions given to update or confirm your desired Directory information.
- PLEASE NOTE THAT, DUE TO THE FRONT OFFICE SYSTEM, OUR SYSTEM ONLY
 HAS ONE PARENT PER FAMILY RIGHT NOW! The email you receive will contain
 directions to add another parent's info to your Directory data if you wish.
- The deadline for updating your information will be **November 11th**. At that point we will close corrections for the printed Directory, although you can request changes to the online directory after that day by contacting the <u>Web Parent</u>.
- Families without an email address on file will receive a paper version of the email.
- NOTE: If you email the Web Parent with a request for your email address to be changed, please also state if you want the change for the online Directory or for the

Alert News distribution, or both.
