FCPS Budget Information for 2015–16 School Year

At the last PTA meeting, Principal Fernandez discussed the 2015-16 school budget. As you read in Superintendent Garza's message to parents about the budget earlier this month, the school system is encouraging parents to make their viewpoints heard about the budget if they wish to do so. As mentioned in the emailed message, "The Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS) **Fiscal Year 2016 request** of the County is very reasonable and pragmatic; unfortunately the County Executive presented a budget to the Board Of Supervisors (BOS) that is \$14 million short of fully funding our budget

which, if approved by the BOS as presented, would result in even more cuts to our already strained system."
