5th Grade Math SOL Date Change

Please make note that the date for the 5th grade Math SOL has changed. This is due to the ability for the students to take an expedited retake if their SOL score is in the 375-399 range. Prior to a student begin given a retake we are required to offer remediation for up to 7 days. Moving the 5th grade Math SOL to an earlier date will allow for remediation to take place and the retake to happen prior to the SOL expedited retakes window closing.
