Self-efficacy is the belief in yourself, that you can do something and do it the best way possible. Responsibility is doing what you are supposed to be doing and giving it your best effort. When students are seen showing self-efficacy and responsibility, they will receive a green actively caring bracelet.

Guidance Lessons

All students receive guidance lessons once a month from their grade level counselors. Mr. Hang works with Family 1, 3rd and 5th grade. Ms. Kim works with Family 2 and 3, 4th and 6th grade.
