As many have heard by now, the Meals Tax that was on the ballot in November failed, and FCPS is facing a serious projected budget shortfall. The Superintendent will be proposing a budget very soon, and a public comment period should follow. As a starting point for possible cuts, please see <u>Budget Task Force document</u>. This is a \$75M cut scenario. The actual cuts may be more or less. The items listed are from a prior year list of cuts voted on by FCPS stakeholders.
