Eco-Tip of the Week

The Price of Convenience-Plastic water bottles are inexpensive, disposable and convenient, but they use a lot of fossil fuels to make and transport, and pollute the environment. Tons of plastic waste are dumped into the ocean, break down and release toxic chemicals and particles. These chemicals are absorbed by small marine life and eventually work their way up the food supply. Send your child to school with a reusable bottle so they can fill it up as needed from water fountains or sinks. Encourage your family to use reusable water bottles and make it a habit of taking them with you whenever you go out. Make a family pledge to not use plastic water bottles for 30 days, and see how much you can save. A plastic water bottle costs 1,000 times more than tap water and it takes 700 years for bottles to decompose. Watch <u>www.plasticoceans.org</u> a film on the impacts of plastics on our oceans.
