Eco-Tip of the Week

• Mantua Recycles! The student-led Eco Recycling team from Ms. Sullivan's class has been working to implement a recycling program in the cafeteria, this program has been running for a few weeks and has been made possible with the tremendous support from our custodians, cafeteria assistants, teachers and students. - May 4 is Annual Bird MWEE (Meaningful Watershed Education Experience) Field Day. 5th Graders will enjoy hands-on learning in their own schoolyard habitat. Students will rotate through three stations: birding with binoculars, bird habitat, and watershed health. Helping students make the connection to the importance of stream ecology is Crook Branch, a tributary of Accotink Creek which is directly south of the Mantua playground. Our citizen scientists will benefit from this hands-on experience as they engage with nature in their own schoolyard to learn about their environment and conservation.
- April 29th is the People's Climate March. The People's

Climate Movement began in Sept 2014 on the eve of the UN Climate Summit when 400,000 people marched in New York City calling for climate action. It was the largest climate march in history and brought together hundreds of organizations focused on climate change.
