AAP Level III Screening

Fairfax County Public Schools provides a continuum of academic services for all students. While access to these services are provided to all students at various levels, students must be considered eligible through a school committee to formally access gifted services on a regular basis. If you wish to refer your child for consideration for Part-time School-Based Services, also known as Level III Services, the deadline for submitting the application form to the Mantua ES office is 4:30pm on Friday, May 12th. Rising 3rd -6th grade student students who are found eligible for school-based services will receive an enrichment lesson weekly. This lesson will be during the school day, in lieu of other content/homework/assignments which the students will still be responsible for.

Parent notification regarding eligibility for Local Level III Services for the 2017-18 school year will be included in the 2017 end of year report card envelope, sent home with students on the last day of school.
