

Even when you think a straw is being thrown away, there are good chances the straw will end up as litter or disintegrate into tiny pieces called microplastic that find their way into our waters. Microplastic pollution is becoming one of the most insidious forms of contamination, harming marine life and polluting waters. Make a personal commitment to say "No" to plastic straws. Whenever ordering a drink, politely request "no straw, please." Encourage your friends and family to take the pledge, too! • Did you know that LED lights are 80% more efficient than traditional incandescent bulbs? Even better they last 25 to 35 times longer than traditional bulbs and the cost has dropped significantly in recent years. For a fun family project identify the highest use bulbs in your house (kids' rooms, recessed lights, bathroom lights, etc.), unscrew (carefully), and take them to the hardware store to find a match! Save money, and help save the environment! Old LEDs and incandescents can be thrown in the trash. However, if you're replacing a compact fluorescent bulb (CFL), they contain mercury and need to be disposed of as hazardous waste. Unbroken CFLs (which screw into standard lamp sockets) may be taken to the returns desk of any Home Depot Store. Fluorescent tubes and bulbs are accepted at the county household hazardous waste sites during scheduled hours.

New Pollinator Garden at Mantua
