Eco-Tip

When planning your upcoming class party, please consider the following, this will help protect the environment and save

some \$'s along the way

- Ask kids to bring their own reusable water bottles. Mantua now has its own refillable water station to use.
- Stick to finger foods! Cut up fruit, chips, crackers and cheese. Avoid using plastic utensils which will never degrade in landfills. For something sweet, consider mini-cupcakes, popsicles or cookies.
- Don't use styrofoam products, which contain styrene which can cause adverse health effects.
- If you need plates, buy small compostable and biodegradable ones. You can find them on Amazon, and also earn \$'s for the school.
- For activities, consider an outdoor event or using recyclable materials for craft projects. Forgo plastic tablecloths and decorations, the kids will have fun either way! Minimize the amount of trash produced it will make set-up and clean-up afterwards much easier!
