# Teachers & Administration:

Dr. Braband has been working with the county government on the budget with the main focus on staff salaries, specifically to make teacher salaries more competitive. There is the plan to make a small shift to admin salaries as well. There is a need for parent support to get this budget approved. All county principals are meeting to discuss resources and teacher hiring & retention.

For the past two weeks, we have been working on teacher evaluations and have started interviewing for next year. We are hoping to have a great candidate for next year.

### Language Survey:

75% of parents and teachers voted to have Spanish as the second language taught at Mantua ES going forward. We still need the school board to sign off on this change and we are currently awaiting approval.

Roof:

Despite the fencing on the roof, we continue to have children getting up on the roof at night and on weekends. Their acts are causing destruction and we have had to take apart walls in order to repair damaged plumbing work. Two classrooms are no longer getting water as a result. It is also extremely dangerous. These children need to be caught.

- WIDA testing was started in January for students with English as a Second Language; receive scores at the end of the school year
- IOWA given to 6<sup>th</sup> graders; receive results in 1-2 months
- Naglieri conducted on Tuesday, February 13<sup>th</sup>; given to 1<sup>st</sup> graders and select 2<sup>nd</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> graders who are ESL and did not receive the CogAT; receive scores in approximately 5-6 weeks
- AAP Screening is currently ongoing
- SOL State Standard of Learning assessments for 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades; everyone takes Reading and Math; 4<sup>th</sup> grade also takes VA History and 5<sup>th</sup> grade takes Science; dates are as follows:
