Principals' Report Jan-Marie Fernandez

Welcome and Happy New Year!

Recent Events:

- The 6th grade classes visited the National Museum of American Indians.
- Some 2nd & 3rd grade students participated in Enrichment with Woodson HS students.
- The 5th grade students participated in the novel-writing program Nanowrimo and presented their work on the 19th.
- On December 21st, we had two Winter Sing-A-Longs. Historically, we have had the whole school in the gym for this event but, given that we now have almost 1,100 students, this was no longer feasible. The Music Department figured out how to do 2 Winter Sing-A-Longs. Our new and fabulous Mantua Staff Band participated as well. The Administration considered the event a success. Feedback from kids and staff was very positive as well.

Testing:

Universal Screener: Required for all K-2nd graders to take 3 times throughout the year. We are in the

Winter testing period. Of 3rd-6th graders, the only students to take this test in the Winter are those students who fell in the 49th percentile or below in the Fall.

This testing needs to be finished by the end of January.

IOWA: Given to 6th grade students who are enrolled in 7th grade math. Dates are

January 14-17. This is an Algebra test. The result from the IOWA along with the 7th grade math SOL score will determine if a student takes Algebra 1 in 7th grade.

WIDA: This is ESL testing for any of students who are in ESL services or who have a

second language at home who have not yet met national requirements. Dates are January 22nd-March 14th. ESL teachers do the majority of the testing and

school counsellors assist.

President's Report (cont'd)

Nick Rousos

- We are getting a new playground (Mr. Rousos showed pictures of the playground). They are going to remove the existing playground and replace it with a new playground that will be approximately 10 sq. ft. larger. It will take approximately 3 weeks to install the new playground. They will let us know when they are coming. We do not know the timing but most likely in the Spring. Summer is not an option.
- Dr. Braband has uploaded the FY 2020 FCPS Proposed Budget: https://www.fcps.edu/about-fcpsbudget/budget-documents. We are very hopeful that the budget as proposed will be the budget as funded. Unlike previous Superintendents, Dr. Braband has work very hard with the Fairfax County Council. The State only funds approximately 20-25% of our budget whereas other Northern Virginia districts get 45-55% of their budget funded.
- The 2019-20 FCPS Calendar is now online. There are no more 3-hours early releases. No time assigned for Professional Development. Not ideal.
- There will be a Lockdown Drill some time this month.

 Regarding the government shutdown, government workers who are furloughed can contact FCPS to be considered for substitution work and no child will be refused food until government is back up and running.
