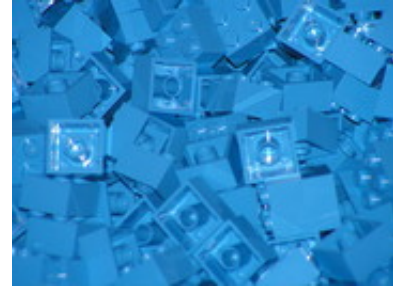
Kids Volunteer Camp: March 3 (Teacher workday)

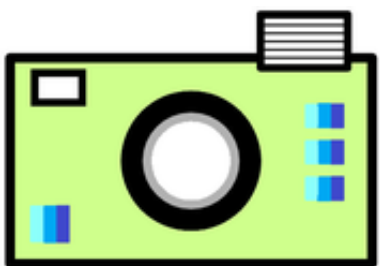

Super Transition Saturday - Career and Transition Services Event

On **Saturday, February 22, 2020**, Career and Transition Services (CTS), the FCPS Parent Resource Center, and several Fairfax County adult service providers will host "Super Transition Saturday" from 9:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. at Luther Jackson Middle School. This is a free event for parents/guardians and

educators of students of all ages with IEPs. Breakout sessions will cover postsecondary education support, the importance of student self-determination beginning in the elementary years, employment support programs, future planning considerations, such as funding needed for services, and CTS support services that are available to students as they progress through the secondary years toward graduation and beyond. A highlight of the day is a parent/guardian and student panel representing a range of challenges and successes. Members of the panel will convey personal experiences and answer parent/guardian and student questions from their perspectives of having been through the transition process. Have You Seen This Sign?

Fairfax County libraries and schools are getting some new reading material, but they're not books! On Wednesday, December 4, staff from the Maintenance and Stormwater Management Division installed educational stormwater signs at five sites across the county. These signs were placed next to bioretention facilities, or rain gardens, to educate library visitors, students, and other community members about their local stormwater facilities.



Produced by ecologists in Stormwater Planning's Watershed Education and Outreach section, the signs highlight the bioretention facilities' ability to filter and absorb stormwater runoff which reduces erosion and pollutants downstream. These facilities improve the water quality in our local streams and ultimately the Chesapeake Bay.

Installing signs provides an educational opportunity for residents to learn about their local environment, on their own time, and brings awareness to the role these facilities play in managing stormwater and protecting our watersheds.

The bioretention sign is the second in a series designed to highlight different stormwater practices across the county. Be on the lookout for more to come!

Absences, Tardies, Early Dismissals and Transportation Change Procedures

At some point of the year, almost every student will either be absent, tardy, leave early for an appointment or need a change of transportation. Please email the office at: MantuaElem.Attendance@fcps.edu and copy the classroom teacher or call the attendance line at (703) 645-6363 for anything related to attendance or dismissal. Email is always the preferred method of communication for clarity purposes.

Absences or late arrivals: Please contact the office by the above method by 9:30am. Robo calls go out at 10 am. If a student is arriving late an adult must walk them into the office and sign them in even if you have notified the office of the late arrival.

Changes in Transportation must be submitted by 1:00 PM to either the email address above or attendance line. The first month of school there will be no bus passes to go home on the bus with a friend. Students receive a pass any time there is a change of transportation. Do not send in changes more than a week in advance except for ongoing changes, see examples.

Early Dismissals should be called in early in the day. An adult on the emergency care form can pick up a student. If you call when you are approximately 5 minutes away from the school then we will try to have the student ready for you otherwise we will call for the student when you arrive. There are NO DISMISSALS between 3:40 PM and 4:05 PM.

Examples:

Please excuse Johnny Smith in Mrs. Jones's class to Kiss and Ride today, June 20, 2099.

Please excuse Fred Flinstone to Kiss and Ride every Monday until further notice.

Please excuse Jane Doe who will arrive at 10:00 am to school due to a Dr. appt.

Let the office staff know if you have any questions.
