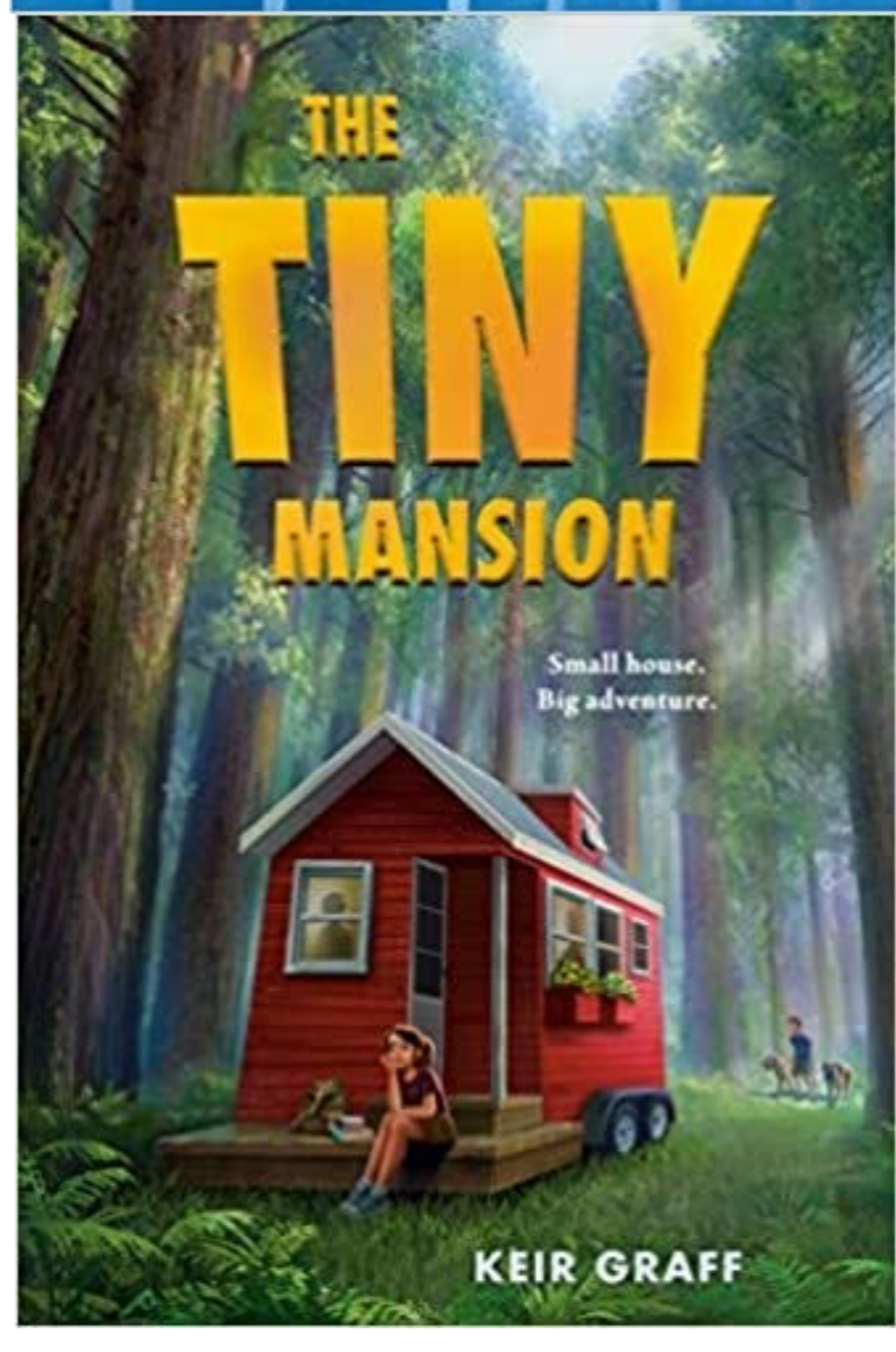
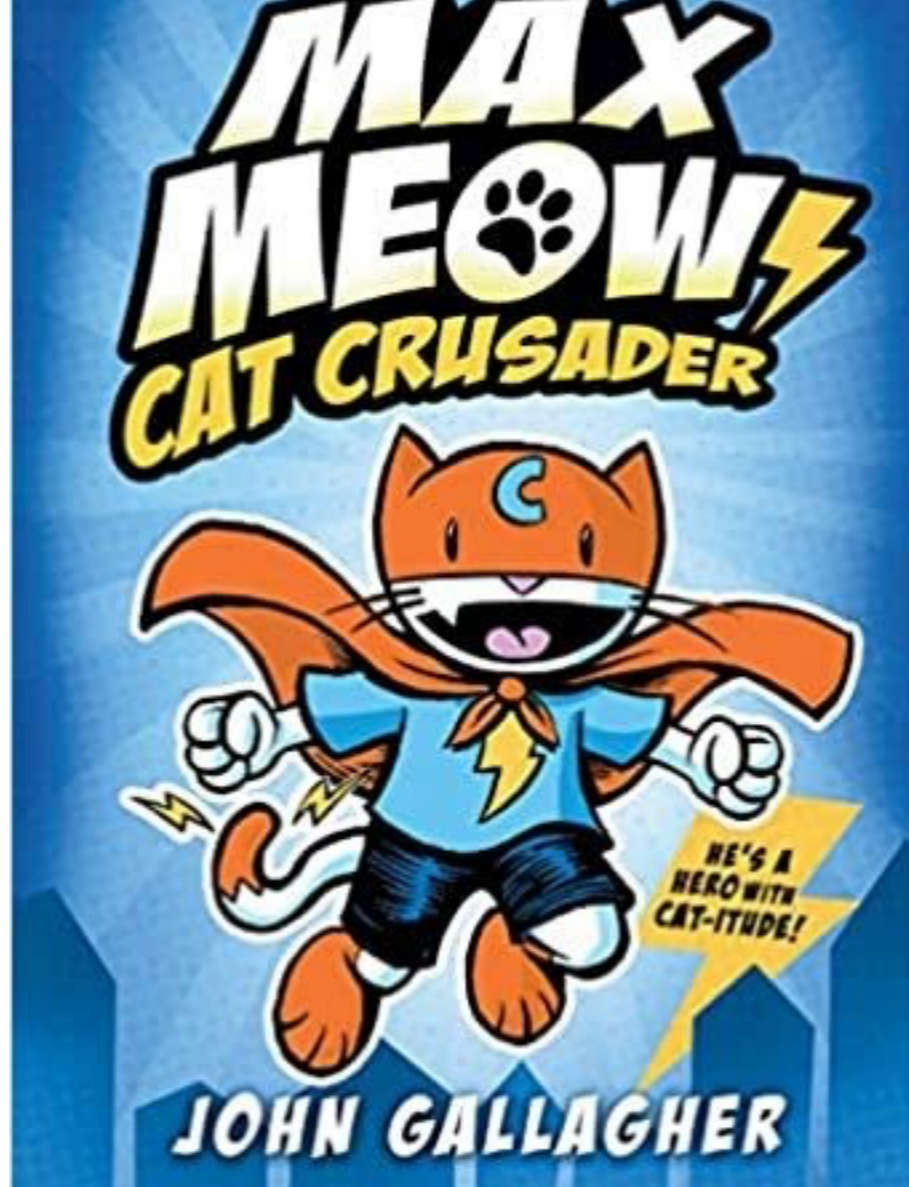
Virtual Author Visits

You can also record messages as groups or as a family! Example messages can include:

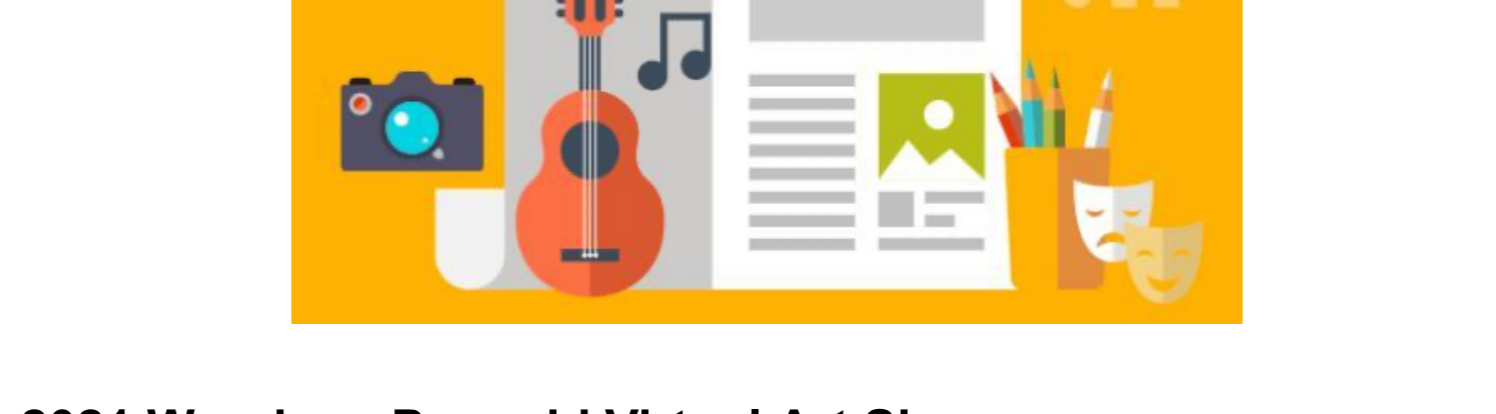
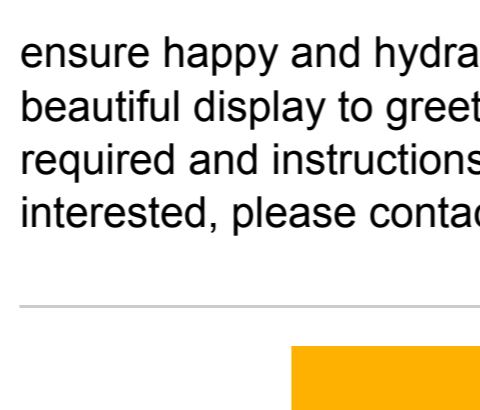
- "Hi Mrs. Fernandez, remember me? Jane Doe from 1997? Good luck with everything!"

Northern Virginia Science and Engineering Fair (NVSE) 2021 - Congratulations to our Mantua Science Fair Participants in the 7th Annual Regional Science Fair, at George Mason University, held virtually in Spring 2021.

Afzar Nasimov (Division 2, Life and Earth Sciences: Does Your Birth Season Affect Your Season Preferences?) Jasha Stauber (Division 2, Physical Science and Engineering Division: 1st Place: The Helium Advantage) and Krish Stauber (Division 2, Life and Earth Sciences Division: 3rd Place: 5 Seconds of Terror) displayed their independent scientific research, and competed against 80 projects from 13 other elementary and middle school schools from Northern Virginia.

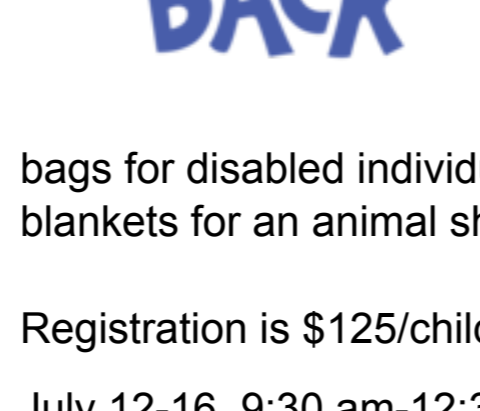
Registration Fee: \$50 – pay information on the registration application – Camp will fill up fast!
