> Mantua Elementary will be participating in the International Academic Competitions' (IAC) US Geography Championship and International Geography Bee programs, in lieu of the National Geographic's GeoBee (which has been cancelled this year). Participating students will take a qualifying exam (called an ORQE) in December 2020, which will be administered by Mantua Elementary. If the student scores high enough, they qualify to participate in regionals in Feb/March 2021. If they score high enough in regionals, they go to nationals in May/June 2021. These regional and national competitions will be virtual. Parents will coach their kids with the guidance and resources provided on IAC's website. Additional guidance and resources will also be provided by the Mantua Parent Coordinator. Ages/Grade: Grades 4-6 Cost: ORQE exam.is free, but there area registration fees for regionals and nationals for students who score high enough on the ORQE.


A few changes this year as we navigate this club virtually:
